









Assembly

1. Fixing the Flange




Fix the flange on your work table with the supplied screws, nuts and washers.

3. Inserting the Adapter (JT/TE)



Slide the adapter along the hose to the end of the handle.

2. Setting up the Tool Arm



Fit the tool arm onto the flange and tighten the allen screw.

4. Mounting the Tool



Insert the tool as far as possible.


5. Place the hose in the clamp





Height adjustment


- The RWT-B Arm allows adjustment for different heights according to your work needs through the vertical axis rule.
- Slide the tool holder to the appropriate height and secure by tightening the lower knob to guarantee stability. Make sure the upper knob is loosened before sliding the tool holder.



Work position adjustment

The RWB-B arm allows adjustment for different positions according to your work needs. The articulated arm covers all work areas.





Ball joint adjustment



The ball joint for Rework Arm allows you to adjust the tool head holder position to suit your work needs.

Press the button or loosen the wheel to move the ball joint.

Both axes have a ruler to carry out the task with higher precision .

Tilting movement:




By holding down the button you can rotate the ball joint up or down.



The movement allows a rotation of -40° to +40°.

Rotation movement:



You can lock or unlock the lateral rotation mechanism by turning the fixing wheel a quarter.



The movement allows a rotation of -90° a +90°.



Maintenance

- Check periodically that the RWT-B is clean, especially the sliding parts and the shaft.
- Use a damp cloth when cleaning. Alcohol can only be used to clean the metal parts.
- Replace any defective or damaged parts. Use original JBC spare parts only.
- Repairs should only be performed by a JBC authorized technical service.



Safety




It is imperative to follow safety guidelines to prevent electric shock, injury, fire or explosions.

- Do not use the equipment for any purpose other than PCB rework. Incorrect use may cause fire.
- The temperature of accessible surfaces may remain high after the unit is turned off. Handle with care.

- Utmost care must be taken with liquid tin waste which can cause burns.

RWT-BREWORK ADJUSTABLE ARM


